On this day a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between Sikkim University and Biotech Park Lucknow. COE of Biotech Park Lucknow, Padma Shree Prof. Pramod Tandon was present on the occasion and also presented a lecture on "Bio- Economy and Entrepreneurship in Nation Building". Bangladesh High Commissioner visits Sikkim University

High Commissioner of Bangladesh to India, Syed Muazzem Ali visited Sikkim University on 16th Septemeber 2019 He was accompanied by Minister (Political), AFM Zahd-Ul_-Islam, Bangladesh High Commission on his visit to the University. Syed Muazzem Ali was born on 18th July, 1944 in Sylhet and obtained his Master's Degree in Science from Dhaka University in 1966. He had professional trainings at the Civil Service Academy, Lahore (1968- 1969) at the School of Advanced International Studies, John Hopkins University in Washington DC and at the International Peace Academy in New York. Specialising in multilateral diplomacy, he has represented and led Bangladesh delegations to various Senior Officials', Ministerial and Summit-level meetings of the Un, UNESCO, Organisation of the Islamic Conference (OIC), Non- Aligned Movement (NAM), Commonwealth, Suth Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC), Group of 77 and World Bank's Development Forum Meetings. Syed Muazzem Ali also delivered a special lecture at the Conference Hall, Barad Sadan, on "Bangladesh India Relations" which was attended by the faculty members, officers, research scholars and students.
